Observations:

This project experienced an outpouring of God's Spirit which resulted in an unprecedented number of decisions. Three (3) of the Four (4) evangelism teams worked in locations where a PM chapel had been built in recent years. One of the chapels, built Eight (8) years ago, has had to tear down the walls in order to build a larger structure over it to accommodate the 200+ persons in the Sunday services.

Also, this project was the beginning of a 4 year commitment to the North Minas Association with Heritage BC of Pensacola and Pioneer Missions to plant multiple churches in cities without Baptist work. The American team partnered with over 66 Brazilian believers from the 4 churches committed to this church planting project and together went to 3 cities to do Prayer walking, street evangelism, and social ministries among other ministries.

Truly this project was anointed by the Lord and besides the many blessings seen during these days, a church planting vision was cast and initiated.

VIII. Conclusion and Challenge for Pioneer Missions

The need for reach Brazil is as great as it was 20 years ago. 50% of the municipalities/cities in Brazil do not have Baptist work. This percentage corresponds to 2,500 specific areas. In addition, 30% of these areas have NO EVANGELICAL work at all. This is NOT COUNTING the large pockets in the Mega-Cities that need Baptist work, like Guarulhos São Paulo with 1.3 million persons and only 4,000 Baptists in 39 churches.

The challenge is before us and as a mission organization we believe the time is now to be a strong partner with Brazilian Baptists, effective catalysts on all levels, and a driving force throughout the country to reach the UNREACHED areas. Pioneer Missions is positioned, like NO OTHER mission organization to make a tremendous impact on the locations that need a Baptist/Evangelical presence to proclaim the GOSPEL.

Pioneer Missions is a great organization with great people committed to the CAUSE of CHRIST and though the challenge is great, our LORD IS GREATER and HE will supply ALL that is needed to accomplish the mission before us!
